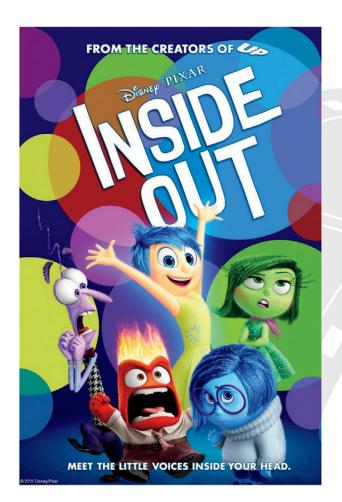

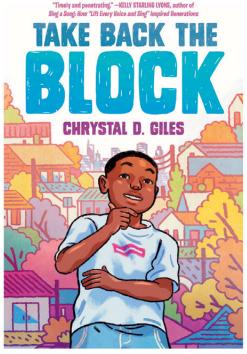


KIM O'NEIL
